Under the President's Report, Jess Robison presented an update of recent VEMA activities and organizational operations. She asked every board member and committee chair to provide her an update if they serve on any taskforce, commission or workgroup representing VEMA. She wants to create a better tracking mechanism to see VEMA's reach.

Under the Executive Director's Report Bo Keeney presented an update on association and management activities. This included the most recent membership numbers, recruitment campaign information, an update on VEMS 2024, the 2024-2025 dues renewal process and an overview of the annual sponsorship program. In particular he noted that the VEMA membership is now at 921 members which is a 25% increase from this time in 2023. The annual sponsorship program is doing well but slightly behind the forecasted budget projections. Conversely the exhibitors and registrations are well ahead of schedule.

Under Unfinished Business the following items were presented for an update

- a) Strategic Plan Workgroup Next Phase (McKinnon and Foresman)
 - a. It was noted that the committee has not finished their work at this time and an update will not be finalized for the 2024 annual membership meeting. As such an update will be presented at the 2024 annual meeting. They are still waiting on committee feedback before proceeding.
- b) Committee policies and SOP's each committee is asked to develop a SOP & policies for presentation at the board meeting.
 - a. Committee chairs are asked to have their SOP in place by May of 2024 for presentation at the June board meeting. Rough drafts are due no later than June 15, 2024 to the VEMA office and President.
- c) Bylaws v. Constitution Caucus voting privileges.
 - a. Motion Robison/Comer to accept the VEMA bylaws committees' recommendations to update the VEMA constitution and bylaws accordingly (See appendix I) and to present these recommendations to the VEMA General membership at the 2024 business meeting. Motion passed unanimously.
- d) IHE Faith Based Associates (Whiteaker)
 - a. The VEMA Executive Committee will establish a taskforce to examine membership classifications w. respect to non-profit organizations and caucuses. The taskforce will work with a membership committee once it is reestablished. Steven Davis will chair this taskforce and each caucus is asked to provide a member as well.

Various Committee Reports, Regional Committee Reports and Caucus Reports were provided. See appendix II

Under New Business and Discussion items the following were presented:

- a) Mass communication strategy:
 - a. It was determined that the Executive Board will review any request for distribution of materials to the general membership until such time as a policy may be adopted. Distribution of member information will redact email address and phone numbers for the time being.
- b) VEMS
 - a. The VEMS committees will update their SOP to authorize the committee chairs to determine who receives conference comps, determine differential pricing for non-profit organizations.
 - b. The VEMS 2024 committee is almost here. There will be 2 hotels, a new conference app, it's close to a sell out again this year, program is posted online and the committee is finalizing details
 - c. 2027 Proposal Kalahari Resort
 - Bo presented an proposal for the Kalahari Resort for 2027 and 2029. The offer is good only until April
 1, 2024. The RFP information has been sent to the Executive Board for their review. No action at this
 time.
 - d. VEMA Board Social & Interest Mixer
 - i. 2 VEMA Board members will be asked to staff a "board interest" booth during each breakout during the conference. Staff will send out a sign-up.
- c) Membership and Marketing Chair Vacancy- Urgent need to fill this position.
- d) Legislative Committee Report
 - a. EM Professionals Week
 - i. The Legislative committee is still working to determine the best time to adjust EM professionals week. Look to the 2025 legislative session for a change/update.
 - b. Update on Legislative Items and Bills of Interest
 - i. One of the main items that is still before the 2024 legislative session is the funding mechanism for VDEM warehouse. Currently one chamber's budget attempts to eliminate the funding.
- e) Motion Jess Robison / Second Leslie Comer to increase the VEMA sustaining membership category from (180 members + 10 individuals) to (200 members + 10 individuals) for \$6500. Motion passed unanimously by email vote on 3/6/2024.
